


Progression Routes for Apprentices 2023 Bricklaying



After completing your Level 2 Apprenticeship, with experience you could pursue career progression routes such as a construction site supervisor, estimator, an apprentice trainer or teacher in further education.

Beyond that, there are opportunities to pursue more specialist paths like heritage work or stonemasonry.

You'll need a <u>Construction Skills Certification Scheme</u> (CSCS) card or equivalent to train and work on a construction site.

If you find you do not have the **Level 3** entry requirements to go to university or study a degree apprenticeship, you could study a Bridging course with LCB to increase your UCAS points and/or enhance your CV.

Remember, you do not have to go on to study higher education straight away, you can go into employment and consider HE at a later point in your life, if and when you want to open up your career options.
