


Progression Routes for Apprentices 2023

Carpentry & Joinery



If you are currently studying at Level 2 you could progress onto one of the above Level 3 options at LCB. If you are currently studying at Level 3, you could progress onto a Degree at university or begin a Higher/Degree apprenticeship.

Career progression routes include: Carpenter, Joiner & Wood Machinist. Beyond that, experienced carpenters can become supervisors, project managers or team leaders. You could also move into different areas within construction such as estimating or contract management, or specialise in an area like heritage restoration or building stage sets.

You'll need a <u>Construction Skills Certification Scheme</u> (CSCS) card or equivalent to train and work on a construction site.

If you find you do not have the Level 3 entry requirements to go to university or study a degree apprenticeship, you could study a Bridging course with LCB to increase your UCAS points and/or enhance your CV.

Remember, you do not have to go on to study higher education straight away, you can go into employment and consider HE at a later point in your life, if and when you want to open up your career options.
