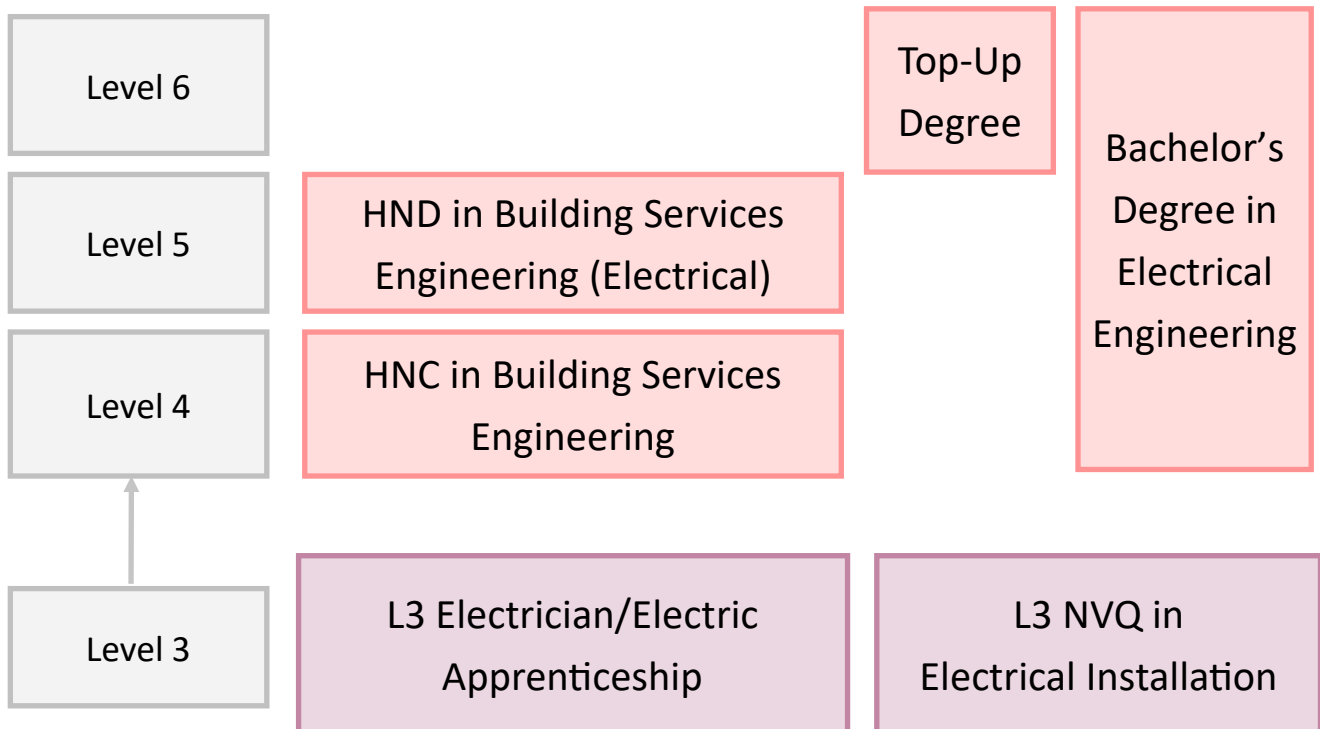




Progression Routes for Apprentices 2023

Electrical



If you are currently studying at Level 3, you could progress onto a Degree at University or continue at Leeds College of Building and study our HNC/HND in Building Services Engineering (specialising in Electrical Engineering) gaining a Level 5 qualification. You can then either continue to university and study for 1 extra year to get a full Level 6, or go into employment.

Career progression routes include: Home inspector, crew foreman, project manager, renewable energy specialist, & electrical design engineer.

You'll need a (ECS) card to train and work on a construction site.

If you do not have the entry requirements to go to university, you could study a Bridging course with LCB to increase your UCAS points and/or enhance your CV.

Remember, you do not have to go on to study higher education straight away, you can go into employment and consider HE at a later point in your life, if and when you want to open up your career options.
