Apprenticeships	EAS Mechanical Ltd training centre offers Government funded apprenticeships in Plumbing & Heating, Electrical Installation, Building Services Engineering Installer (Heating and Ventilation) and Gas for individuals employed both locally and further afield. All qualifications are delivered to a Level 3 Standard and are enhanced by various manufacturers showcasing new products or technology. Programmes delivered are Electrical Installation, Plumbing and Heating and Ventilation.	The partnership model with EAS was set up to support both LCB and EAS to deliver niche provision, that only a few Colleges run. Over time this has developed, and the partnership is a strong model, supporting the local construction sector. For example, for Heating and Ventilation, within a 20-mile radius of EAS Mechanical, only two other training providers exist. Neither offer the block model of delivery which some employer's demand.
